Leftovers With Annie - Episode 1

Get those leftover paint cans out of your home and use them in your decor!

Step 1

In a well-ventilated area, gather your supplies to be spray painted. Continue to spray your clean 24 canning lids and 24 caps with a combination paint and primer in one.

Step 2

While your lids and caps have are drying up to 1 hour, gather your twine and plug in your hot glue gun. With the dry lids, start threading them through a 2 foot length of twine. Make sure you pull them through the twine facing the same direction. Pull the thread tight in the shape of a circle to make the pumpkin shape.

Step 3

With the twine pulled tight, make a knot to keep the lids from falling out of the pumpkin shape. The lids should now look more like a pumpkin. Feel free to add in a cinnamon stick as a top, a spring as a vine and add in personality!
