

DIY: MAKE YOUR OWN RACETRACK

ON A WALL USING RUST-OLEUM MAGNETIC PAINT



How to make your own Racetrack on a wall using Rust-Oleum Magnetic Paint

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Supplies:

- ✓ Rust-Oleum Magnetic Paint
- ✓ Painters Tape
- ✓ Foam Brush
- ✓ Drop Cloth
- ✓ Paint Pen (to draw the street lines)



Steps:

1. Find the perfect space on your wall. You can create one long racetrack for drag racing, a looped racetrack or a perfect oval.

2. Clean your wall with soap and water and let dry.

3. Spread out your drop cloth.

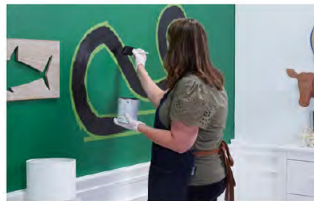
Tips: Unlike regular paint products, magnetic paint primer is very thick, very sticky and can splatter.

4. Using painters' tape, tape out your racetrack.



5. Apply Rust-Oleum Magnetic Paint using a foam brush.

Tips: Buy a brush that you can throw away after because it's hard to clean! Applying multiple thin coats is better than applying heavy coats.



6. Apply three coats of primer 30 minutes apart.

Tips: Magnetic paint is a primer but covering it with more than two coats of regular paint significantly degrades its magnetism!

If you decide to apply a coat of primer on top, make sure you wait up to 4 hours.

7. Once the magnetic paint has dried, use a paint pen in any color to draw the lines or road markings!
